**REQUIRED ATTIRE and APPROPRIATE CONDUCT
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

(Applies to any person associated with the Pageant)

The most important aspect of being a member of the Orangevale Chamber of Commerce court is that you are a Goodwill Ambassador and required to represent the community of Orangevale with high standards. In doing so you are a very visible role model; you will be watched, admired, and people will look up to you. It is for this reason that the following rules and guidelines have been provided and should be followed:

- Contestants are not permitted to drink alcoholic beverages or smoke prior to, during, or after any activity. Random drug testing will be in effect if deemed necessary.
- Females between the ages of 3 to 19. Age is based on day of Pageant.
- Never given birth.
- Never been convicted of a felony.
- You must love Orangevale.
- Other titles held must not conflict with pageant duties.
- Submit a completed application and have paid the \$50 entry fee. \$25 for Wee Miss.
- Dresses, skirts and suits are appropriate attire for chamber functions. One set of earrings are to be worn at a time. All tattoos and other piercings MUST be covered. Bare midriffs are not permitted and shorts/skirts MUST be at an appropriate fingertip hemline.
- As a goodwill Ambassador for the Orangevale chamber and the community, you should display the best of etiquette at all times and in all places. This includes both personal and social websites. You are a role model for young children who will admire you. Your role is very important and by winning you are forever a part of Orangevale's history and future.
- Requirements must be met during reign unless board approves circumstances.
- Any problems that arise should be discussed with the Pageant Chair and the Board of Directors. We are concerned for your well-being and want to help make your year fulfilling as possible. This is a once in a lifetime opportunity, you should make the most of your year!

All activities are strictly chaperoned by committee members. Contestant can have one (1) Parent/ Guardian at scheduled activities and practices. Other Family members, friends and boyfriends are NOT allowed at activities or practices. Inappropriate behaviour may result in disqualification. Punctuality and appropriate apparel (discussed at orientation) are expected. Contestants are responsible for having a ride to and from practices.

A panel of qualified unbiased judges will be chosen by the Orangevale Board of Directors. The pageant consists of on stage presence and personality, eveningwear, fun wear, and love for Orangevale. Judges will choose one Miss Orangevale, Jr Miss Orangevale, Little Miss Orangevale and Wee Miss Orangevale to reign for one year as Goodwill Ambassadors for the Orangevale Chamber of Commerce.

PHOTOGRAPHER/MEDIA RELEASE: In consideration of prizes, and/or awards, I hereby give the Orangevale Chamber of Commerce permission to use my name, statement, photograph and video recordings for publicity and advertising purposes. All materials become the property of the Orangevale Chamber of Commerce and not to be used without prior authorization. This permission extends to any person, agent and or agencies, media representatives or others authorized by the Orangevale Chamber Board of Directors.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT: I hereby waive any claim I may have or hereafter acquire against the Orangevale Chamber of Commerce or its agents and any person affiliated with the organization for losses, injuries or damages suffered by me during any activities and the pageant itself.

Orangevale Chamber of Commerce will award the crowned Miss Orangevale, Jr Miss Orangevale, Little Miss Orangevale and Wee Miss Orangevale a crown, sash, title, and prize package.

In case of emergency, I hereby give my consent to give such attention that may be necessary by a physician and/or medical personnel.

The Orangevale Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to adjust or change these rules at any time with notification to all contestants.

I do hereby agree to abide by the duties, responsibilities, required attire, appropriate conduct, rules and regulations associated therewith and I further agree to:

- Cooperate with the Orangevale Chamber of Commerce, the Pageant Chair and/or their appointed representatives during my reign and throughout the process of the Pageant.
- Keep scheduled appointments and appearances requiring my presence in a prompt and timely manner. If I am unable to attend or I am late, I will contact the Pageant Chair and the Orangevale Chamber office.
- Most importantly, I will serve as a positive role model and Goodwill Ambassador and I will conduct myself at all times in a manner that will not dishonour my title or community and I will wear my crown proudly with dignity and grace.

I have read the rules and Regulations and the Required Attire and Appropriate Conduct guidelines and agree to abide by the same. I **do not** currently hold a working queens obligated title where I am committed, under contract, to another town, its sponsor and a Director. I fully understand that should I, in the opinion of the Orangevale Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, fail to fulfil the duties required of me, I will forfeit my title, as well as all rights to prizes and awards received by me in association with or as a result of the Miss Orangevale Pageant and that I will be required to return these items to the Orangevale Chamber of Commerce.
